Meet at 0930 a.m. at The Ridings Car Park to share lifts.

Starting at the car park off Frampton green, this is a flat walk of around four and a half miles. We begin by skirting round part of the Frampton Court Estate passing several lakes, one of which is the home of Frampton Sailing Club. Through the Sailing Club and a farm, we then enter a large wood which eventually emerges to follow along the banks of the pretty river Cam. Across some fields and through a small Nature Reserve, we meet the Sharpness Canal at Cambridge Arms bridge. Our walk back to Frampton is then along the canal towpath with fine views over to the river Severn and beyond to the Forest of Dean. Along the 3/4 mile path through the wood, there are a number of very muddy parts, but the rest of the walk is good underfoot. There are several gentle stiles to negotiate. A pub lunch will be available afterwards for those who would like to partake.
