Welcome to SVB strollers. Ahead of each walk, details will appear below about length, terrain, where and when to meet and the name and contact for the leader. You can decide if it's for you and just turn up at the start. Dogs and children welcome too.

Meet at 9.30am at the Riding's playing fields car park to share lifts.

Starting at Frenchay Common adjacent to the White Lion pub (post code BS16 1LZ), and there is parking around this area. The walk begins following the roads of the area of old Frenchay village and picks up the footpath of the Frome valley Walkway. It then follows the river Frome by rough track to the picturesque area of Snuff Mill at Stapleton. There are number of interesting historical areas along the way.

At this point there is the facility of a coffee stop. There is a small kiosk where tea, coffee and very nice cake can be bought and there is also an outdoor area for seating, overlooking the river. There is also some covered seating if it is raining.

The return walk back to Frenchay Common is on the opposite side of the river which will take the group at a high level back along the river valley finally onto the Vassal Estate. After this the walk covers an area of the park back down to the river where it crosses back into Frenchay Village and to the White Lion pub.

The walk is mainly on level fairly rough track on the outbound walk, but on the return it is very rough track with a couple of steep climbs. It will be necessary to negotiate around and over a number of fallen trees.

The walk in total is approximately 4.5 to 5 miles.
