

SVB Strollers

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Welcome to SVB strollers. Ahead of each walk, details will appear below about length, terrain, where and when to meet and the name and contact for the leader. You can decide if it's for you and just turn up at the start. Dogs and children welcome too.

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Meet at the Ridings car park at 9.30 a.m. to share cars.

We leave Berkeley by a footpath walking alongside the stream, known as Berkeley Pill. A warning for those who like to wear shorts there were a few nettles!! We cross a road leading to the power station and join The Severn Way footpath. Soon the power station is visible to our left and we turn right to proceed along a short stretch of the Severn, with Sharpness Docks ahead. Somewhere along the embankment we will stop for a drink and you might want your binoculars, as there is plenty of wildlife to see, which may include geese and lapwing.

Turning inland we go through two fields and pass beside Oakhanger Farm before taking a bridleway back to town. We can take a stroll up to the church, a rarity with a separate tower and then on to Berkeley tea rooms for a light lunch. No pubs possible!!!
